



## Dear Friends and Supporters,

As you have seen on previous updates and in multiple recent publications of *The Voice*, we have been hard at work on the construction of our new Pando Permanent Supportive Housing apartment complex that aims to help young people in our community who have experienced homelessness.

Last Fall, we were blessed to be able to celebrate a groundbreaking ceremony with the Mayor of Indianapolis, Joe Hogsett. This marked the beginning of the construction process to achieve our goals.

After this ceremony, the work began on the apartments. LCFS, with the support of Co-Developer and Contractor TWG, elected to use innovative Permanent Modular Construction (PMC) to expedite the building process. PMC is an alternative construction process where most of the assembly is done in a factory. All the floors, walls, ceilings, lighting, and systems for our units were done before coming to the site.



On February 9<sup>th</sup>, we celebrated “stacking” these containers and invited board members and other stakeholders to watch this exciting process.

Throughout that week, the TWG team was hard at work making sure all the pieces of the puzzle fit together smoothly and correctly. By the end of the week, they were able to put all 30 containers together and are currently working on all the other aspects needed to make this project a success.
