

Dear Heavenly Father,

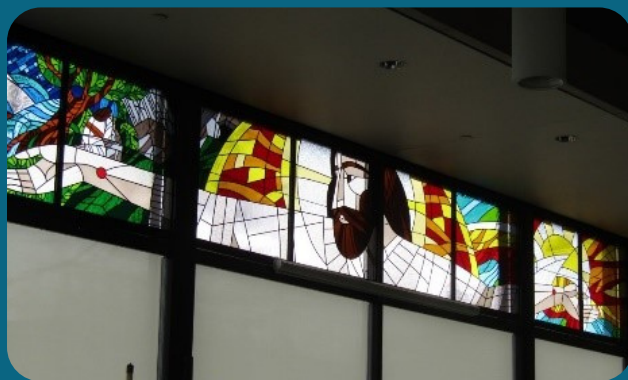
