Founded in 1883, LCFS has served the community for over 137 years. Begun as an orphanage, LCFS currently offers a focused array of programs of compassionate care and counsel to children and families through a targeted continuum of care of the following programs:

Lutherwood Residential Treatment Center programming for youth ages 6-21 living on our campus who have experienced trauma & require behavioral health care services

IMPACT

a program within Lutherwood dedicated to serving youth survivors of human trafficking

Trinity House

an independent living group home for young men ages 14-21 to promote life skills development

Home Based

family preservation, supervised visitation, care coordination, counseling & life skills development for youth & families

Emergency Shelter Care

a safe haven for youth ages 12-18 who need emergency shelter from dangerous situations

The Sharing Place

a material assistance program that provides food and clothing to families in need on the east side of Indianapolis

SEED

spiritual growth services & assessments offered to residents; programming includes voluntary weekly chapel service and Bible study
