We offer Bible study, chapel services, and time set aside for private prayer or conversation for our residents and staff in our residential programs.



The Sharing Place Food Pantry is a material assistance program which provides food for families. Additionally, The Sharing Place offers SilverBox, home delivery service to about 55-60 homebound individuals to serve the most vulnerable in our community. The Sharing Place is staffed by our wonderful and talented volunteers recruited from the community and local congregations.
