



Delivery Service Looking to Expand

Silver Box, home-delivery program for those experiencing food insecurity with transportation challenges, was created by King of Glory Lutheran Church in partnership with The Sharing Place to help serve the most vulnerable in our community. This service started as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 as a way to serve those who may not feel comfortable coming out to The Sharing Place to receive the goods they need.

Currently, King of Glory Lutheran Church, Christ the Savior Lutheran Church, and Holy Cross Lutheran Church are partnering with LCFS to deliver Sharing Place food items, along with additional items generously donated by the churches supporting this program.

As COVID-19 restrictions eased, the program continued; we now hope to expand service capacity by working with additional local churches. We are currently delivering once per month, but hope to expand this option to twice monthly to serve clients with health-related transportation challenges by adding additional church partners.

Sandy Snoke and Hans Loyda from King of Glory Lutheran Church are two volunteers

who coordinate all logistics for the deliveries each month, and work with all the partner churches to make sure they have enough volunteers as well as supply some of the items provided to the families. Volunteers from the partner churches pack nonperishable boxes of food (families make their selections based on our current inventory each month) which are delivered to the families along with produce, meat, household/toiletry, eggs and milk.

A \$2,000 donation was recently given to this program to help fund the home delivery of much needed food to those unable to visit the Sharing Place in person. When clients feel they no longer need these services, they remove themselves from the program so that someone else may also get the help they need.



Pictured above to the right are two wonderful people who came in and prayed with the people who provided delivery services. Recipients give thanks and ask God to bless those providing this assistance, and our volunteers are seeking God's blessing for clients as well.

Full-Choice Model is Back!

This past month at The Sharing Place, the full-choice client service model returned!

This model of operation has been used at The Sharing Place for a very long time but had to be put on pause due to the COVID-19 virus. Now clients can get back into The Sharing Place and begin making choices for themselves about which foods they prefer for their families.

While "check-in" for families will continue to occur in the entry area (not the office area), shelving/shopping will be moved from our temporary location near the fridge/freezers, to the other side of the large pantry storeroom. Client selection options will be increased as well. Our volunteer shifts times will be slightly modified on client service days to accommodate the operational needs to enhance client services.



The Sharing Place is also shifting to mask optional but will consider placing another mask mandate should cases rise once again. As we continue progressing back to a new normal, your safety is a top priority for us. Please respect one another's decision to wear a mask or not wear one.
