Pastor Schreiber will start off the event with an invocation and share the connections between faith and walking. The walk will be following the paved part of the park's trails and will be less than three miles in distance.

The park's naturalist Mr. Dylan Allison will also be there to talk to the group about the park's history and nature. Dylan will inform the group about the Norwegian concept of "FriLufsLiv", that can be loosely translated to "open-air living".

Sven may host additional Spiritual Walks in the future, so stay tuned to learn more!



The 2020 walk took place throughout September, October, and November. Due to COVID-19, the walk that usually takes place in Europe was moved to Southern Indiana, but it still was a great success.
